



Academic Success






Success by Student Group


This display shows PARCC ELA & Math performance levels for each student group. No data is shown for groups with fewer than 10 students.



School Highlights

Academic Courses

Field offers a comprehensive academic program including language arts, math, science & social studies. Also offered is Spanish, a fine & applied arts program (FACS, STEM lab, art and music), & PE. Accelerated offerings are available for language arts & math (Alg & Geo). An academic support program is also available. The iPad is a 1:1 tool.

Career Development Courses and Programs

Students received exposure to various careers through our STEM lab program and through the health and wellness curricula.

Physical Education, Heath and Wellness

Each student receives a 40-minute daily PE course. Health and wellness topics are part of the PE curriculum for each grade.

Athletics

Field Middle School offers an interscholastic athletics program for all grades. An emphasis on sportsmanship, leadership and being a student-athlete is integrated into the program.

Other Programs and Activities

Field Middle School offers several before and after school opportunities, including beforeschool library and a student council. All students are welcome to be part of student council. In addition, Field produces a yearly musical, open to all students. Finally, students are encouraged to participate in a range of service learning activities.

School Personnel Resources

We have a diverse offering of school personnel resource such as a social worker, psychologist, special education teachers, an intervention specialist and & a school-certified nurse. Field offers an ELL program with dedicated ELL teachers, and many teachers who are pursuing an ELL endorsement. All staff is highly qualified. Class sizes are small.

Field Middle School is on a campus that includes a full scale auditorium, a large gymnasium, a small gymnasium, two science labs, a dining commons, an athletic field, and a full learning center/library.
